All nominated students will be invited to the **Science Day at the RI on 15 February 2005.**

Following a two stage selection process 5 students will be invited to attend the **International Science School in Sydney from Sunday 3 July to Saturday 16 July 2005.**

Candidates should be outstanding students, aged at least 16 years on 1 June 2005 in the first year of an A-level course or S5 Students in Scotland. It is particularly important that potential candidates from 11-16 schools should not be omitted because they have transferred to another establishment. If you teach in an 11-16 school and know of a suitable candidate who has now transferred please contact the student and make a nomination.

To make a nomination please send names and addresses of your candidates to Pam Jenkins at ASE HQ (email pamjenkins@ase.org.uk) who will send the application forms and further details direct to the student for completion.

Application forms will need to be returned directly to the local Regional Secretary of ASE by **21 December 2004 at the latest.**
